Plans that are offered to governments include Office 365 E 1, Office 365 E3, and Office 365 E5.

Microsoft Office 365 plans ensure top level services that meet federal requirements and Department of Defence security requirement guidelines.

Microsoft 365 for schools offers the unique opportunity for academia to provide students with a variety of collaboration, creative, and safe production tools with the ability to add students at no extra cost. <u>Microsoft 365 also offers an education centre</u> that allows you to learn more about Microsoft products. Currently there are three programs available for schools: the A1, which is free with no commitment and offers basic Microsoft programs; A3, which features a more robust toolset; and the A5, which offers the most advanced suite of tools and services.
